1. Shtibl - Yiddish: A small house of prayer for the Hasidic sect of the Jewish faith.
2. Shekhinah - Hebrew: The dwelling of God's divine presence
3. Talmud - Ancient Jewish Rabbinical law, which the textual basis of Orthodox Judaism
4. Galicia - A medieval name for a region of Eastern Europe comprising modern-day Poland and western Ukraine
5. Stalingrad - city in the Soviet Union where major War World II battle, the 1952-53 "Battle of Stalingrad" was fought between German and Soviet armies
6. Rosh Hashana - The Jewish New Year high holiday, celebrated for two days in the early autumn
7. Babylon - An ancient Mesopotamian city in present-day Iraq, originally a Semitic administrative center in the Akkadian empire dating to the third century.
