- 4. Galicia A medieval name for a region of Eastern Europe comprising modern-day Poland and western Ukraine
- 5. Stalingrad city in the Soviet Union where major War World II battle, the 1952-53 "Battle of Stalingrad" was fought between German and Soviet armies
- 6. Rosh Hashana The Jewish New Year high holiday, celebrated for two days in the early autumn
- 7. Babylon An ancient Mesopotamian city in present-day Iraq, originally a Semitic administrative center in the Akkadian empire dating to the third century.
